
Any notices regarding Funerals or anything else that might happen during the week will be notified on the notice board in the foyer of the Church

2nd Reading .. St Paul to Romans 8:8-11 Gospel .. John 11:1-45




HELP DURING CORONA VIRUS CRISIS:


