

At the doors of the Church:

On Palm Sunday , from 9am to noon, blessed palms will be available at the doors of the Church for anyone who wishes to take them, along with a copy of the account of the Lord's Passion from St Matthew's Gospel.

On Holy Thursday from 7pm to 9pm: the altar of Repose with the Eucharist visible, will be placed near the doors of the Church so that people may pass by and pray if they wish.

On Good Friday from 3pm to 6pm, a Crucifix will be placed at the doors of the Church to be acknowledged by any who wish to come by. It will be another time for a moment of prayer.

On Easter Sunday morning, the Paschal Candle will similarly be placed at the doors of the Church from 9am to 12noon.

Easter tapers and Easter water will be available to take away

CONFESSIONS:

Holy Thursday at 7.30pm

Good Friday at 7.30pm

Holy Saturday at 12 noon

Confessions can occur in a place considered suitable by penitent and priest (e.g. outside) (masks can be provided).

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

For anyone wishing to be anointed, Fr Frank will be available from 11am to 12noon on Holy Thursday, for individual anointing. (The anointing can take place outside the Church if necessary e.g. in the open air (gloves will be used))

If anyone is ill, please do not hesitate to call Fr Frank (9598 1511)

If a funeral is required, again please contact Fr Frank to make arrangements (9598 1511).

Fr Frank will be saying Mass privately at 9.30am each day of Holy Week — you may like to reflect and pray at that time.


