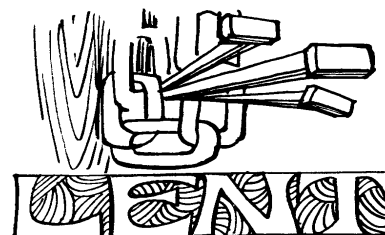

CHILDREN'S LITURGY CRUCIFIX : You may have noticed that there is a crucifix placed under the Rose Window of the Sacred Heart at the back of the Church. This is used for the Children's Liturgy at the 9am Mass - one of the children leads the others out carrying this crucifix.

GOOD FRIDAY

The Friday liturgy is unusual. Firstly, there is no Mass on this day. There is also a silent beginning and end to the liturgy. It begins at 3pm deliberately as this is the hour of the Lord's death. We have readings from Scripture including the full account of Jesus' Passion and Death from St John's Gospel followed by the long intercessions for the whole world. Then we proclaim and venerate the Cross. Finally we have communion. We have communion in the bread consecrated at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday night.
