Because of the government restrictions on numbers (1 person per 2 sq metres), we are still limited to the amount of people allowed in the church, and we need to obtain contact tracing information for all attendees.

Due to these limitations, it may mean that this Christmas is different (in many ways !) in that we attend a different place or time. Let's not forget that only a few months ago we could not even get inside a church or attend Mass. We are fortunate to be in this position. Although not yet ideal, or 'normal', at least we have the possibility of getting to Mass. And it can also help to to consider what is really important: my devotion to the Lord and the Mass rather than a time and place.

Over the coming summer weeks, we will have a 'holiday' bulletin- a shorter Bayside bulletin for the holiday time.

Pope Francis Proclaims 'Year of St Joseph'

In a new Apostolic Letter entitled <u>*Patris corde*</u> ("With a Father's Heart"), Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph as a beloved father, a tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows.

The Holy Father wrote *Patris corde* against the backdrop of the Covid-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of "ordinary" people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day.

In this, they resemble Saint Joseph, "the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence," who nonetheless played "an incomparable role in the history of salvation."



At the conclusion of his Letter, he adds another prayer to St Joseph, which he encourages all of us to pray together:

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
To you God entrusted his only Son;
in you Mary placed her trust;
with you Christ became man.
Blessed Joseph, to us too,
show yourself a father
and guide us in the path of life.
Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage,
and defend us from every evil. Amen.
