PROBLEMS WITH CHURCH TILES, ROOFING &

GARDENS: Several parishioners have expressed
concern about the current maintenance of our
building and gardens. The SH Buildings &
Maintenance Committee (BMC) has been
reformed with seven skilled parishioners led by
Vin Savage and Jim Smith. It is working with
Catholic Church Insurance on how best to repair
the sandstone tiles on the church façade, which
have fallen off three times in storms over the last
three years. Repairs to all tiles are expected to
be done early in 2021. The BMC is also working
on roof wear & tear, a safety railing for the
Memorial Garden, a preventative maintenance
plan for buildings and on garden improvements.
The BMC requests your usual co-operation for
the temporary safety fencing in place until the
full tile solution at the best costs can be made..
