## From The Pastors



Dear Friends,

In the Gospel reading this Sunday we hear of the first disciples being called

by Jesus. Mark's account depicts Jesus calling Simon, Andrew, James and John out of their ordinary activities and inviting them to share in His mission. He doesn't simply call them to some different type of activity and behaviour. He calls them to a completely different way of seeing things. He calls them to a radical change of heart and mind.

Implied in their decision to abandon what they were doing and follow Jesus is a letting go of the fear they had, secure in the fact that this truly was the Messiah that was calling them and that He would walk beside them. Jesus' call to repentance was a call to understand what He could do in their lives. He saw more in them than they saw in themselves and in calling them recognised what they were capable of if they trusted in His guidance.

Next weekend we will be gathering with the leadership groups from our communities to discuss various aspects of the Mission, especially leadership structures and the ways we can all be involved in the activities and mission of the Church here in Bayside. As we move forward, let us pray that we may be open to what God is calling us to. Let us, having first recognised God's love for us, and his call in our lives, 24th January, 2021



## **REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE TO CHURCH BUILDINGS:**

The SH Buildings & Maintenance Committee (BMC) has been reformed with several skilled parishioners led by Vin Savage and Jim Smith. It is working with Catholic Church Insurance on how best to repair the sandstone tiles on the church façade, which have fallen off three times in storms over the last three years. Repairs to all tiles are expected to commence shortly. The BMC is also working on roof wear & tear, a safety railing for the Memorial Garden, a preventative maintenance plan for buildings and on garden improvements.
